What are Child Safety Standards?

- » Compulsory **minimum standards** for the protection of Children

What must school's do?

1. Maintain an **organisational culture** of child safety,
2. Maintain & Communicate a **Child Safety Policy**,
3. Establish clear expectations – **Code of Conduct**,
4. **Implement Screening Processes** – WWCC / Reference Checks,
5. **Respond to & report** suspected child abuse,
6. Identify, **reduce or remove risks** of child abuse;
7. **Include & empower** children to identify inappropriate behaviour and report it.

- » Never post photos, videos or comments on social media relating to their interaction as a volunteer...
